SETUP

We have arranged for plenty of extra move in and move out time. Move in times are as follows:

Tuesday, Nov.14 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. **Boat Dealers ONLY!**

Boats may be pre-staged outside on the Fairgrounds Midway. (On the opposite side of the lakes from Expo and Entertainment Halls.) If you are unsure, please ask before dropping a boat!

Wednesday, Nov.15 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. **Boat Dealers ONLY!**

Boats will begin moving into Expo and Entertainment Halls per the schedule you will receive at least one week in advance. Please do not attempt to move into the halls prior to your scheduled times.

Thursday, Nov. 16 – 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. *Move in for ALL exhibitors*

Boats will continue to move in per the schedule. Boat dealers, please adhere to the scheduled times.

All other 10 x 10 and open space exhibitors may move in on this day.

Friday, Nov. 17 – 8 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. Limited move in for ALL exhibitors

No vehicles are allowed in the buildings on Friday morning. All move in MUST be completed and all vehicles MUST be moved from in front of and behind the halls no later than 9:30 a.m.

MOVE OUT

Sunday, Nov. 17 5pm–10 pm **Monday, Nov. 18**8am–5pm

All exhibitors MUST be out of the halls no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, November 18. NO EXCEPTIONS. If arrangements are made in advance, boat dealers may stage boats on the Fairgrounds Midway for another day for return to their lots.

FORKLIFTS

We have retained the services of Jack Johnson and his team to operate forklifts and assist boat dealers in positioning their boats. Jack will have multiple lifts, so, boats can be removed from their trailers.

Jack will be contacting boat dealers at least a week in advance and scheduling their move in. The move in schedule MUST be followed by all boat dealers.

EXHIBITOR PARKING

On all show days exhibitors MUST park in the designate exhibitor parking lot. With their parking passes, exhibitor can enter at the Orient Road Entrance and follow the signs to the exhibitor parking lot.

EXHIBITOR BADGES

You will receive your exhibitor badges when you check in at the registration desk at move in.

Exhibitor badges must be worn for admittance into the entrances with-

out charge or for admittance during non-show hours. Exhibitors are entitled to a specific number of badges in relation to the total number of square feet occupied by the exhibitor.

4 badges

Multiple booth exhibitors

2 badges for every booth after the first, up to a maximum of 12.

1,000 Sq Ft

6 badges

2,000 sq ft

12 badges

GENERAL ADMISSION PASSES

As a courtesy to exhibitors, general admission passes good for all weekend are available at the show office at a cost of \$2.50 each. They can also be purchased at the registration desk at move in. General admission tickets may be left at the "will call" window at the ticket office. A valid ID must be shown to pick up these passes.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited inside the building and in the outside exhibitor space.

TABLE/CHAIR/CAR-PET RENTALS

Inquiries about this should be directed to PME Expo Services at 407-730-3886 or customerservice@my-pme. com. All inquiries and orders MUST be made directly with PME. Everything you need to know is spelled out in the provided Exhibitor Services Kit. NOTE: Be sure to order early as costs do go up considerably if you wait until the last minute.

ELECTRICAL SERVICE

This MUST be ordered directly from the Florida State Fairgrounds. Order forms are available in the Exhibitor Services Kit. All inquiries MUST be directed to the appropriate authorities at the Fairgrounds. NOTE: Again, order early as costs do go up as we get closer to the show!

SECURITY

Exhibit halls are locked down each night. Exhibitors are not permitted onto the show floor prior to 8 a.m. No overnight admission is allowed. You must have a badge to be admitted into the show for pre-opening set up.

LIABILITY

Reel Animals Boat Show & Fishing Expo, sponsors, Florida State Fairgrounds or any other agency, organization or individual associated with the show assumes no responsibility, nor will they be responsible for loss, theft or damage to any equipment, merchandise or other items at the show.

If you plan to use your own carpet, please consult with show management before using any tape on the floor. The removal of said tape will be your responsibility at the conclusion of the Show.

EQUIPMENT, MOTOR VEHICLES, ETC.

The operation of any vehicle or machinery is prohibited without the permission of the show producer. Also prohibited is the use of helium balloons, oils burning fluid, kerosene, naphtha, propane or gasoline for mechanical or other purposes.

BOAT DELIVERY

Boats, trailers, etc, parked in the parking lot prior to and during the Show will be left at the risk of the owners. Reel Animals Boat Show & Fishing Expo or any other agency associated with the Show shall not be liable for lost damaged or missing property. Boat dealers will be contacted by Jack Johnson and scheduled for a specific time to move into the halls. This does not affect booth exhibitors or open space exhibitors who are not boat dealers.

FREIGHT HANDLING

All freight deliveries and shipments MUST be scheduled through PME Expo Services. Information on how to do this is included in the Exhibitor Services Kit.

EARLY DEPARTURES

No booth may be dismantled or equipment removed from the building or outside exhibit areas prior to 5 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 17, unless prior arrangements have been made with show management.



DRIVING DIRECTIONS

FLORIDA STATE FAIRGROUNDS

4800 U.S. 301 • Tampa

FROM LAKELAND

- Head west on E Walnut St toward S Indiana Ave (253 ft)
- 2. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto S Indiana Ave (344 ft)
- 3. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto E Lime St (0.6 mi)
- 4. Turn right onto Sikes Blvd/N South Route Continue to follow Sikes Blvd (0.5 mi)
- 5. Continue onto Kathleen Rd (2.5 mi)
- 6. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left to merge onto I-4 W toward Tampa (0.4 mi)
- Follow I-4 W to US-92 W/E Hillsborough Ave in Hillsborough County. Take exit 7 from I-4 W (23.3 mi)
- 8. Merge onto I-4 W (22.7 mi)
- 9. Use the right lane to take exit 7 to merge onto US-92 W/E Hillsborough Ave toward US-301 W/Busch Gardens (1.7 mi)
- 10. Use the right lane to merge onto US-92 W/E Hillsborough Ave (0.2 mi)
- 11. Use the right lane to take the ramp to Riverview (0.3 mi)
- 12. Merge onto US-301 S (0.4 mi)
- 13. Turn right at Elm Fair Blvd (125 ft)
- 14. Turn right (0.2 mi)
- 15. Slight left (0.3 mi)
- 16. Turn left Destination willbe on the left.

FROM ST. PETERSBURG

- 1. Follow 19th Ave SE and 3rd St S to I-175 W
- 2. Head south on Beach Dr SE toward 19th Ave SE (82 ft)
- 3. Turn right onto 19th Ave SE (0.41 mi)
- 4. Turn right onto 3rd St S (1.1 mi)
- 5. Turn left onto 4th Ave S (449 ft)
- 6. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto 4th St S (315 ft)
- 7. Follow I-275 N and I-4 E to East Lake-Orient Park. Take exit 7 from I-4 E
- 8. Use the right 2 lanes to turn slightly right onto I-175 W (signs for Route 175/S Bay Dr/Route 275) (0.9 mi)
- 9. Use the right 2 lanes to merge onto I-275 N toward Tampa (0.9 mi) (27.7 mi)
- 10. Use the right lanes to take exit 45B for I-4 E toward Orlando (0.5 mi)
- 11. Continue onto I-4 E (2.1 mi)
- 12. Keep right to stay on I-4 E (3.3 mi)
- 13. Take exit 7 for US-92 E toward US-301 E/ Riverview/Zephyrhills (0.2 mi)
- 14. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for US-301 S/Riverview and merge onto US-301 S (0.7 mi)
- 15. Merge onto US-301 S (0.2 mi).
- 16. Turn right at Elm Fair Blvd (427 ft)
- 17. Turn left (135 ft)
- 18. Turn right (446 ft)

SUBJECT: TAX OBLIGATIONS

In compliance with Florida Department of Revenue regulations, we are responsible for notifying the Department of Revenue of vendors and exhibitors for the show. (It's no secret, as we publish the list online anyway.) We are asking for your cooperation int he following manner:

When you mail the balance of your payment, those of you have a current Department of Revenue tax certificate number, please list it on the invoice. We'll turn a list of vendors into the department with these names and numbers shortly after the show. It will then be your responsibility to report the amount of sales and taxes collected. Write the certificate number of the invoice in the space provided.

The state sales tax for Manatee County (where the show is held) is 6-1/2 percent. You are responsible for the collection of this amount on your sales. You can include sales tax in your pricing or collect it on top of your prices. There is no sales tax on service-related items. To find out if you fall into that category, please contact that department at the number below.

For those of you coming from out of state who may make this your only Florida appearance, don't worry. The Department of Revenue usually provides one of its temporary kits. You pay the annual fee on the spot (\$5), then report your sales and collections on a form provided in the kit. Again, this is the responsibility of the exhibitor to file and complete all paperwork.
